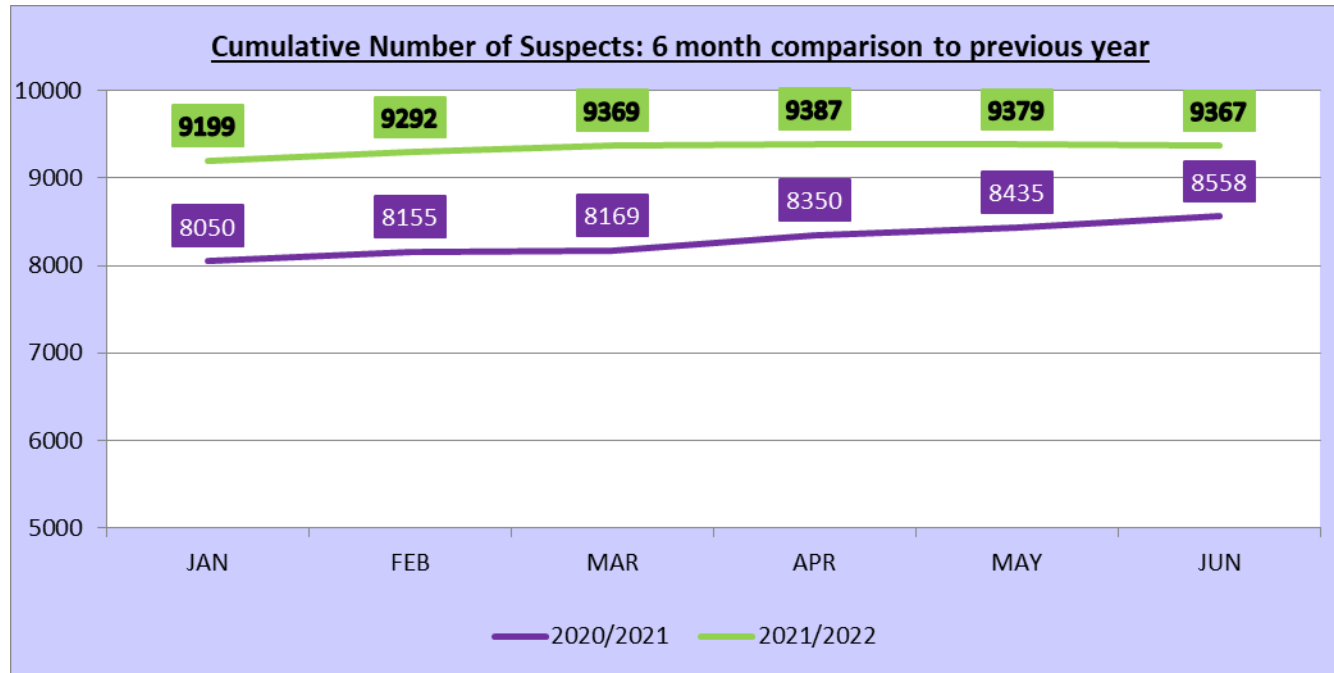

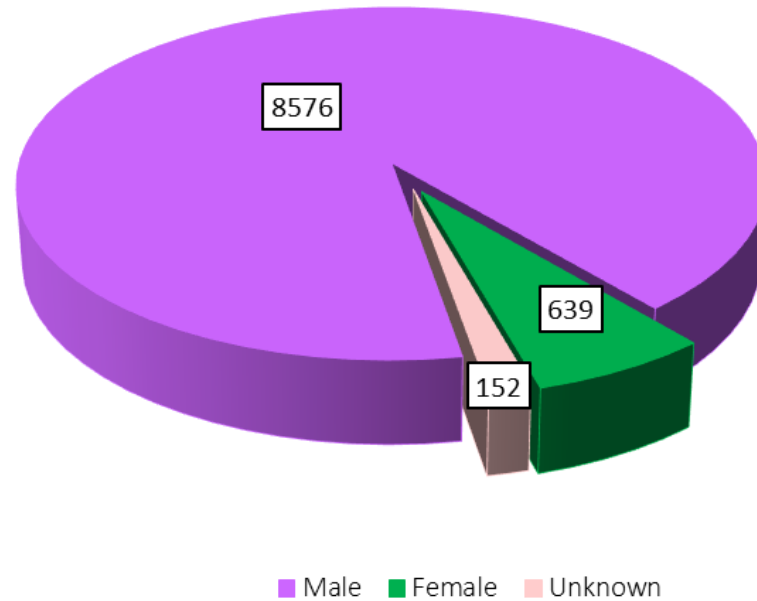

# Suspect: 6 Month Comparison

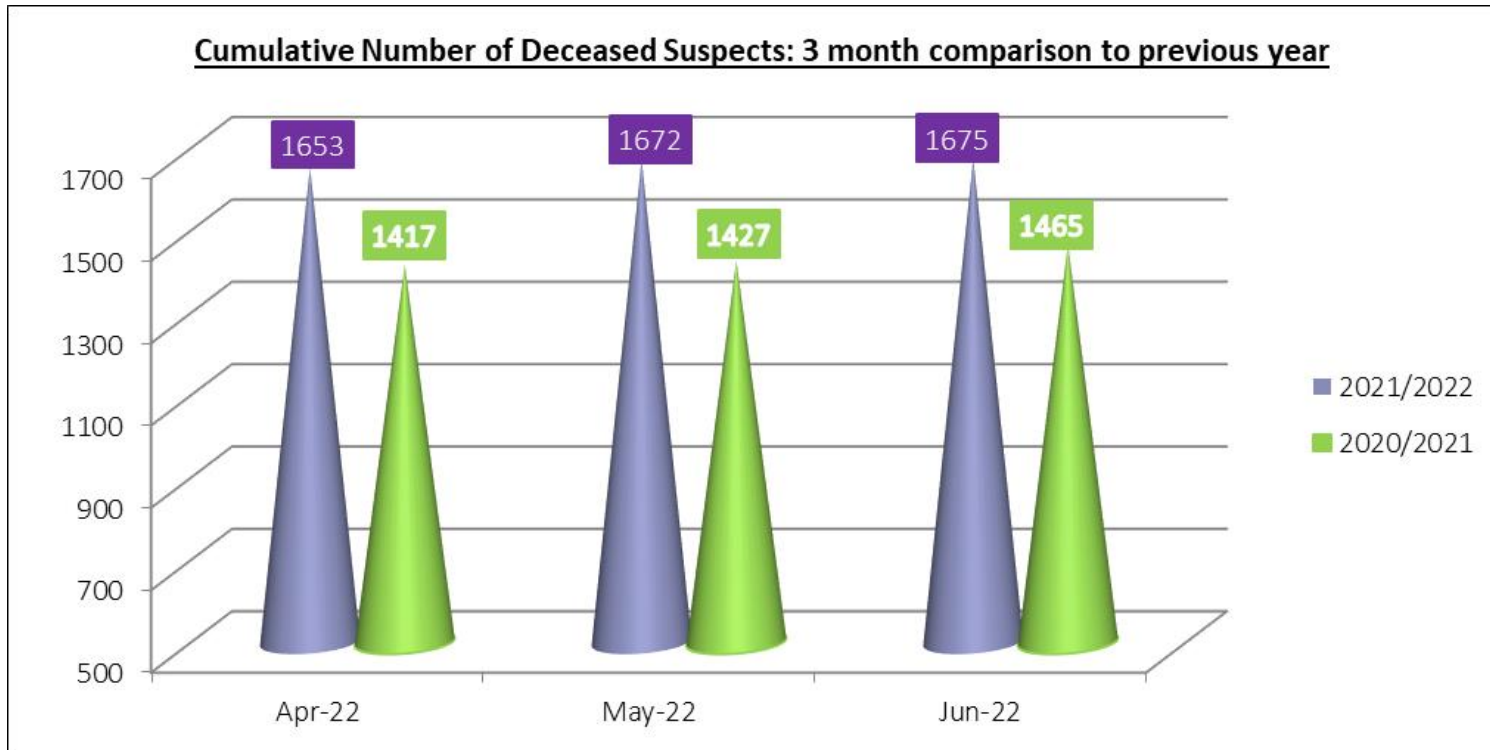


# Suspect Gender

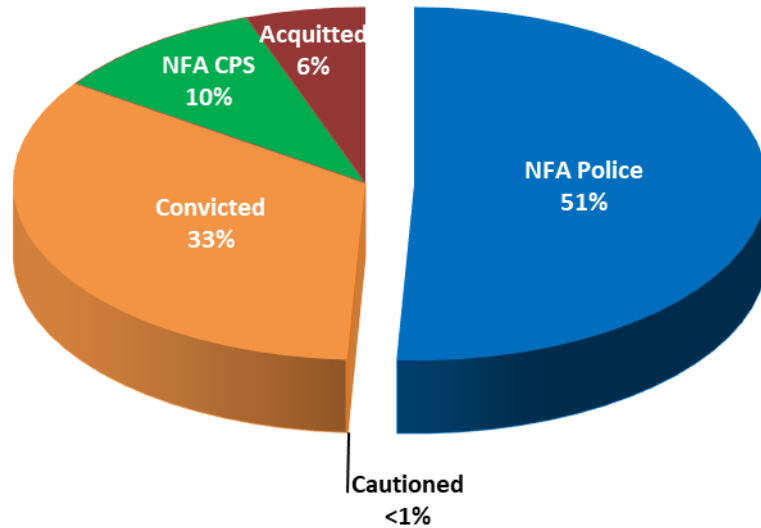
Cumulative Gender Breakdown up to June 2022

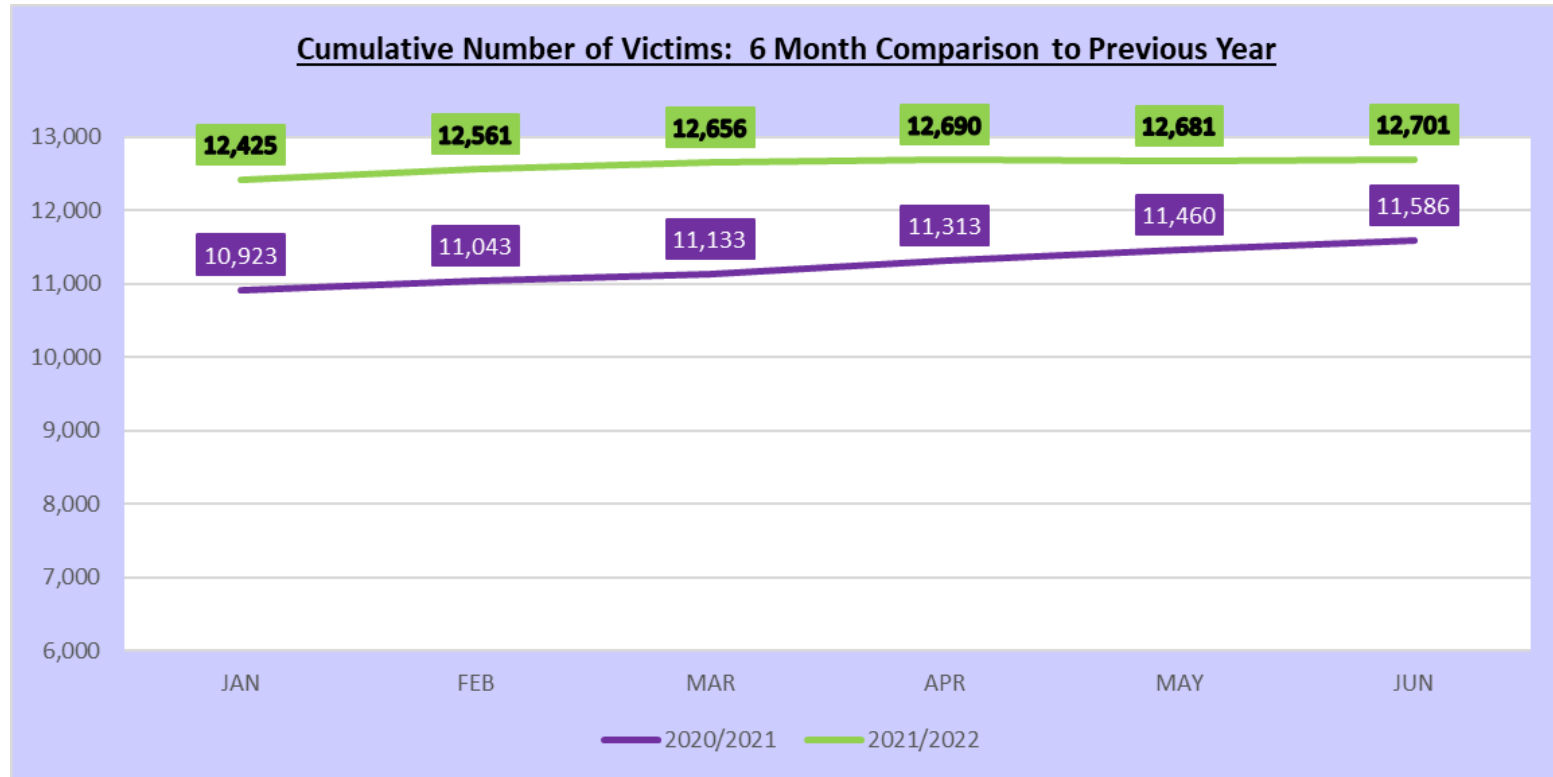


## NFA Police Top Reasons

- Suspect deceased (30%)
- Victim does not support police action (22%)
- Suspect not identified/traced (21%)
- Insufficient detail/evidence (9%)

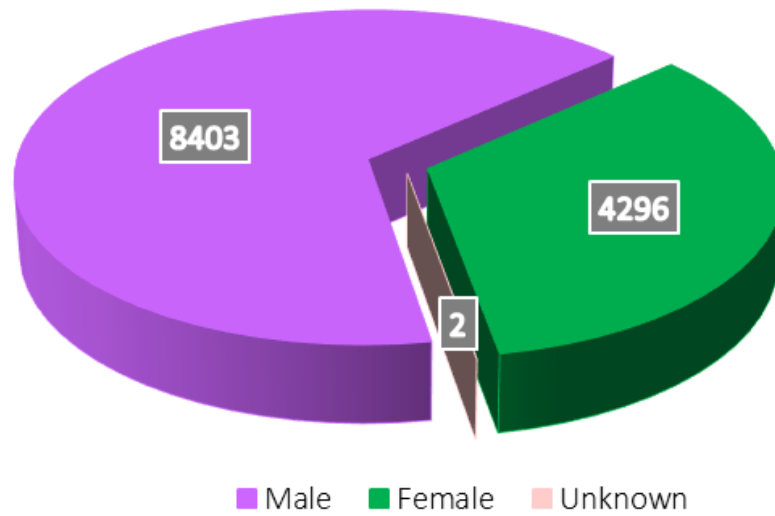
These figures are based on current data provided by forces in relation to Operation Hydrant criteria offences and therefore cannot be compared to national conviction rates.

# Victims: 6 Month Comparison

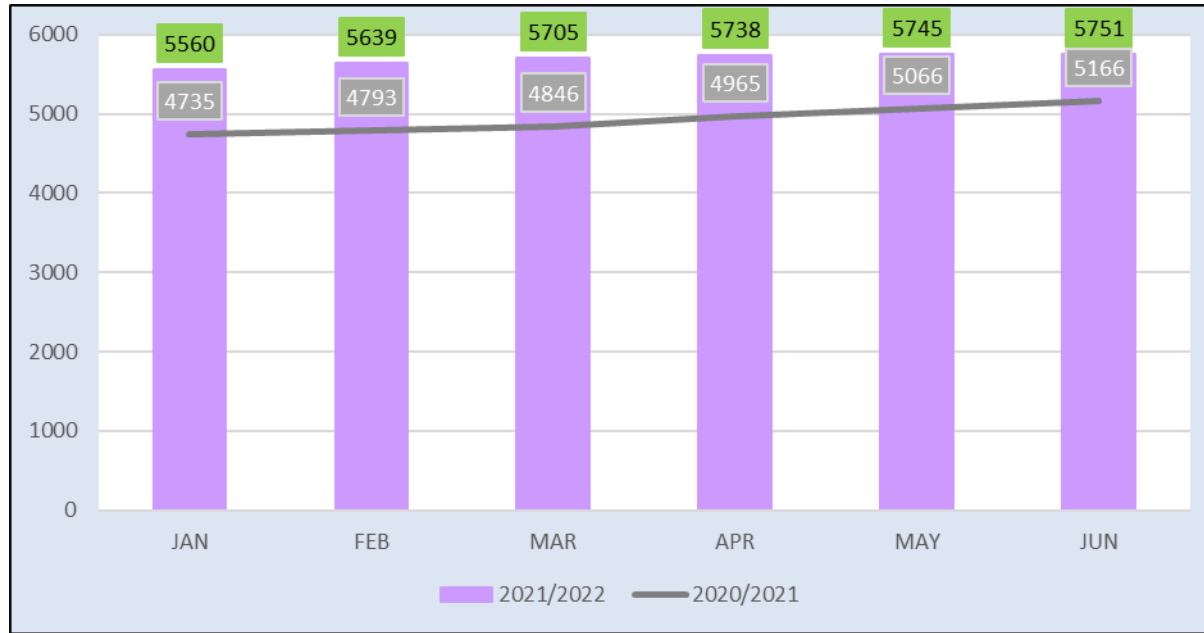


# Victims: Gender

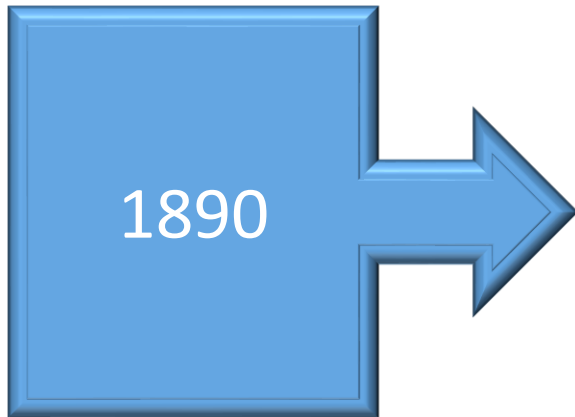
