

# NCB Sub-Board Highlight Summary – DDaTCC **JULY 2025**

## HIGHLIGHTS FROM THE LAST QUARTER:

- 37 forces have now responded to the letter circulated to Chief Constables to strengthen NCB membership and build a network across all forces; this includes:
  - Regional Leads and deputies identified to represent their areas at the National Change Board quarterly.
  - Single Points of Contact (SPoCs) for forces across England and Wales, Police Scotland and PSNI.
- Introductory events held by NCB Chair on 16<sup>th</sup> June and 26<sup>th</sup> June. Over 40 delegates attended. Focused on performance and delivery requirements.
- Community View proof of concept and dashboard presented at various meetings.
- National Change Board held 02.07.2025. Good Attendance and presentations from the Blue light and the home office were shared.

## STRATEGIC RISKS/ISSUES IDENTIFIED & TREATMENT:

Objectives – the National Change Board oversees the delivery and implementation of operational and business change in Forces impacted by national Policing technology programmes and related activities. The NCB Terms of Reference and membership has been refreshed to align to the broader scope of DDaTCC and the other three sub-boards and the following three objectives have been prioritised for 2025/26:

- 1 - Develop and implement a refreshed Community View service for Policing (see progress noted under highlights)
- 2 – Formalise a Policing Blueprint for national programme Resourcing
- 3 – Provide Benefits Realisation oversight across national Policing digital programmes
