

NCB Sub-Board Highlight Summary – DDaTCC **APRIL 2025**

HIGHLIGHTS FROM THE LAST QUARTER:

- A letter has been circulated to Chief Constables to strengthen NCB membership and build a network across all forces, **which includes:**
 - **Regional Leads** and deputies identified to represent their areas at the National Change Board quarterly.
 - **Single Points of Contact (SPoCs)** for every force to receive updates, provide reactive timely responses to requests for engagement, feedback and/or socialisation of business change information as required.
 - Improved attendance at NCB on 08/04/25.
- **Next Steps:**
 - May/June - Initial acknowledgement email of introduction to all SPOCs from the NCB SO, followed by a full network virtual meeting with the national lead to fully introduce the NCB aims, ambitions and expectations of the ancillary roles.
- Community View proof of concept and dashboard are in development – as detailed in the written update documents for DDaTCC. Progress presentation also shared with NCB members 08/04/25.

STRATEGIC RISKS/ISSUES IDENTIFIED & TREATMENT:

- **NCB-R-25-001 NCB Membership.**
 - Limited progress made through Chiefs Net letter to raise awareness of the new National Change Board. As at 03/04/25 only **50%** of forces had responded with a named individual, and only **5/9** regions had identified a lead to represent their area at the quarterly NCB (see attached status slide) Contact will be made with direct with individual forces.
- **PDS Survey – concerns regarding initial response rate. Next Steps:**
 - Extended closing date and reminders sent
 - Cross reference circulation list with new NCB SPOC network
 - Seek support from Chief Officers where necessary
 - 1:1 engagement and completion opportunities to be explored

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FORWARD LOOK FOR THE NEXT QUARTER:

- The NCB will review a summary of the principles that have been used within the OCiP review to develop the overall Blueprint model further.
- Continue to build the National Change Network across policing and host an online introductory event to set and manage expectations. Emphasise the performance delivery requirement and accountability for all NCB members to engage at regional and local level.
- Continue to develop and embed the new NCB format as outlined in the refreshed terms of reference.
- Further develop the partnership with Police Digital Service to fulfil the Community View proof of concept ensuring *policing realises the benefits of the programmes.*

DIGITAL STRATEGY AREAS OF FOCUS:

- NCB delivery plan to be developed and aligned to the ambitions, pillars and priorities of the NPDS when finalised and published.
