HIGHLIGHTS FROM THE LAST QUARTER:

- The NCB terms of reference have been drafted and circulated for comment.
- Community View meeting 17.01.25:
 - PDS will develop and deliver the community view and use this as a proof of concept as to how a sustainable approach can be adopted. This will include developing a uniform reporting dashboard, performing a landscape review of the status of national programmes and delivering a roadshow event which will inform policing of the status of the landscape and give the opportunity of national programmes to gain constructive feedback by March 2025.
