Purpose of my Request:

Deputy Commissioner Stephen House was the deputy to Commissioner Cressida Dick who resigned due to loss of confidence by the Mayor of London.

Subsequent to her resignation, significant findings have been published of deeply entrenched corruption, discrimination, racism & homophobia.

DC House was appointed by Comm. Dick and continued in that role, including acting commissioner role, until the current commissioner was appointed.

With reference to the NPCC media statement released on 8 August 2022 (attached), could you please confirm:

Former Deputy Met Police Commissioner Stephen House led the review to completion and publication on 20 November 2023.

NPCC Response:

The NPCC does hold information captured by your request and I can confirm Sir Stephen House led the review until 1st March 2023, from which point Alan Pughley led the review.
